Subject: Impact Racing equipment acceptability at the Mojave Mile and Magnum

Because our Tech Inspection procedures have changed somewhat, and some time has passed, this memo is being issued to restate our existing policy regarding the use of safety equipment manufactured by Impact Racing in years past.

As you may know, all Impact Racing safety harnesses, arm restraints, window nets, driving suits, gloves, socks, shoes, underwear, and head socks manufactured in the years 2008 and prior, were decertified by SFI a couple of years ago. They are no longer certified for racing use and their SFI tags are no longer valid.

The present Mojave rules require SFI certification for driving suits only, and only for auto Driver Classes AA, A and B. Therefore, in those three auto Driver Classes only, pre-2009 Impact Racing driving suits are NOT acceptable for use.

Since Driver Class C does not require any SFI certified clothing, Class C auto drivers may wear the older decertified suits if they wish.

The other items mentioned above are not required to be SFI certified at this time and may still be used, subject to our normal equipment rules.

Impact Racing products made in 2009 and later do still retain their SFI certification and are acceptable for use, again subject to our normal equipment rules.

Finally, since Impact Racing helmets are certified by the Snell Foundation rather than SFI, they are unaffected by this issue, and they may continue to be used subject to our normal helmet rules.
